

INSERTION IN THE PORTUGUESE SYSTEM OF FORCES



GNR is a Security Force with a military status constituted by military elements organised in a special corp.



OBJECTIVE

Share on key aspects related to planning of advising activities to be performed within a crisis management environment when local law enforcers in the domains of law, order and rule of law are unable or hampered to do it.



REQUIREMENTS FOR PLANNING: Ownership of the host country

Ensure the transition of knowledge, skills, tools and capacity with respect for the full ownership of the host-country's authorities.



REQUIREMENTS FOR PLANNING: Host country absorption capacity

- ✓ The level of ambition of advising activities needs to carefully mirror the actual capacity of the host country to absorb it.
- ✓ Members of the host organisation often have to "re-think" complete problem solution strategies and at the same time, they have to run their daily business in a changing environment.



Management of time

- ✓ Advising requires patience –time- in understanding how and why certain practices prevails, working with locally relevant examples, discussing locally relevant solutions and allowing messages to be absorbed through repetition at a pace which suits the advised and his/her organisation.
- ✓ Advisors need time to reflect on why the local counterpart(s) might be resistant to any change in certain areas also, to change perspective when adequate.

Copying with the mandates' timeframe.



Cultural awareness

- ✓ Knowledge of the host culture and sensitivity to cultural differences; advising activities are to be planned with respect for the culture of the host country.
- ✓ The respect for local culture must never compromise core
 Fundamental Rights values.



Coordination with actors present in the host country

- ✓ Planners are to identify the other members (e.g. other international missions or organisations, bilateral programmes, NGOs, military components) of the international community present in the host country and indicate the need to coordinate with them.
- ✓ The need to assess if other actors of the international community are already involved in advice activities and the need for the development of a good cooperation and coordination with them to achieve synergies must be stressed trough the planning documents.



Identification of material needs as facilitator to advice-driven activities

- ✓ The identification of any material needs that might facilitate
 advising tasks must be foreseen in the planning process
 including its budgeting perspective and the establishment of
 Capability Projects.
- ✓ Avoid to be seen as an "equipment-deliverer" only (e. g. funding of seminars, leaflet or booklet printing, a teambuilding away-day for advising counterparts).



Horizontal approach of these key aspects in all planning documents

- ✓ Alignment of all planning documents at the different stages.
- ✓ Planning documents are the basis for any mission benchmarking, evaluation and reporting; advising objectives, tasks and actions need to be measurable and therefore based on objectively verifiable indicators.
