NATO UNCLASSIFIED ADMINISTRATIVE DETAILS

a. Conference venue

The course will be held at the <u>Starhotels Metropole Rome</u>, located in *Via Principe Amedeo*, *3*, *00185 - Roma* (Italy).

The training hours are Monday to Thursday, 08:30 to 17:00 and Friday, 08:30 to 13:00.

b. Registration

Applicants are kindly requested to return by mail their PAF (annex C) to trainingsa@nsfacoe.org no later than 11th OCT 2020.

c. Language

The course will be held in English.

Level 3 in English proficiency is required according to NATO STANAG 6001: Listening (3); Speaking (2); Reading (3); and Writing (2) or according to Common European Framework of Reference for Language level B2-C1/Upper Intermediate-Advanced level).

d. Classification

The overall classification of the course is NATO UNCLASSIFIED.

e. Security measures

Participants are requested to bring their military/civilian passport or ID card to support their identification in order to receive the security badge that will be delivered on the first day, upon registration. This security badge must be carried throughout the event.

f. Visa Requirement

Attendees are responsible for arranging the required permits to enter the Italian territory (Request for Visit) by consulting their own HQ or embassy for procedures.

Participants, or their national authorities, are responsible for visa arrangements (if needed). Participants are advised to contact, well in advance, proper diplomatic agencies for up to date information. It is the individual's responsibility to apply and obtain their visa and to have the proper travel documentation.

g. Medical service

No medical support will be provided by the NATO SFA COE. Medical expenses must be paid by the individuals or their insurance agencies. All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance.

h. Course fee

The course fee is 150.00 € and will include the ice breaker and all coffee breaks. NATO SFA COE strongly encourages the use of bank transfer payment for paying the course fee. Payments by <u>cash on site</u> will be accepted too, as last resort. Failure to pay course tuition fee by 13:30 on Wednesday will result in the suspension of the course completion certificate for the student and the organization being put into collection status until the fee is paid.

i. Accommodation

Participants are responsible to arrange their own accommodation.

NATO SFA COE recommends staying at <u>Starhotels Metropole Rome</u> (4 stars). The Centre has made pre-booking of double Rooms € 130/day. Room prices reservation are available only by using the "Reservation Request" form attached to the PAF (appendix 1 to annex C).

Booking must be done no lather than 22nd OCT 2020. After this deadline the hotel does not guarantee the rooms availability and preferential rates.

The hotel is near the "Roma Termini" train station in the city centre.

j. Transportation

Course participants are expected to cover their own travel costs.

I. Dress code

The dress code is combat uniform for military personnel; Smart Casual for civilians.

m. Distance Learning option

Due to the ever-changing pandemic situation, the NATO SFA COE will adopt, as backup, a Distance Learning (DL) course in case of an escalation of restrictions or a new lockdown. Tailored instructions will be delivered in that eventuality.

Tuition fee is requested even if the course will be run in DL.

n. COVID-19 precautions and notices

The NATO SFA COE will adhere to Italian Government directions, guidance and regulations for business operations.

ATTENDEES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THE ITALIAN MINISTRY OF HEALTH'S LIST OF RISK AREAS TO DETERMINE THEIR ELIGIBILITY PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE COURSE. THE LIST CAN BE MODIFIED AT SHORT NOTICE AND SHOULD BE CHECKED PRIOR TO TRAVEL.

The NATO SFA COE accepts <u>no liability and will not reimburse</u> any travel and accommodation expenses incurred as a result of travel from a designated risk area.

The NATO SFA COE will not accept student registrations from the countries identified as a high-risk area above mentioned. This also includes students that have travelled to these countries in the previous 14-days, even if students possess a Medical Certificate declaring a 48-hour COVID test. Please note this is not a restriction on the student's nationality, but on their geographic location. National and organizational travel restrictions are the responsibility of the student.

The Italian authorities will permit entry to Italy from the countries on the Italian Ministry of Health list of high-risk countries; however the NATO SFA COE will not be able to support the student during the 14-day quarantine required or with COVID-19 testing.

Classrooms will be set-up in respect of social distances. However, all persons participating to the course are required to **maintain social distancing**, **wear a face mask** (when necessary) and have their **temperature taken**. Participants not adhering to these requirements will not be allowed to the course. Please note medical waivers for face coverings will not be accepted.

o. Participants' selection

Due to reduced classroom capacity the NATO SFA COE will conduct a selection for the course in order to assure the participation to all possible international institutions. Selected participants will be warn by **15**th **OCT 2020**, in order to let them book their accommodation and arrange their own transportation.
