#### AIM

To illustrate how the Security Force Assistance Concept (MCM-0034-2014) has been originated in NATO and how SFA is intended by the reference of NATO publication, the AJP 3.16 -Allied Joint Doctrine for Security Force Assistance.

# b. Registration

# c. Language

The course will be held in English.

Level 3 in English proficiency is required according to NATO STANAG 6001: Listening (3); Speaking (2); Reading (3); and Writing (2) or according to Common European Framework of Reference for Language level B2-C1/Upper Intermediate-Advanced level).

# d. Classification

The overall classification of the course is NATO UNCLASSIFIED.

# e. Security measures

Participants are requested to send annex to the PAF their military/civilian passport or ID card to support their identification in order to receive the accreditation to the course.

# f. Course fee

The course fee is <u>100.00 €</u>. Bank transfer and credit card payments are both accepted.
