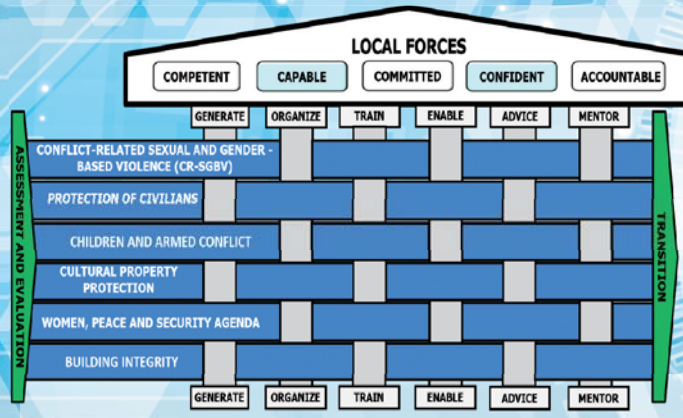

NATO DOCTRINE

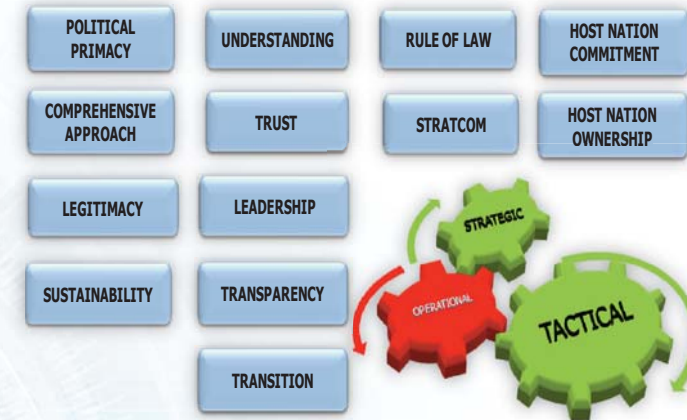


MISSION
