SFA Operators Course

AIM

The aim of the course is to improve the competency and effectiveness of SFA operators working in current and future missions of defence and related security capacity-building. The course enhances the practical understanding and application of NATO SFA operators working as part of a comprehensive and integrated approach. Course participants will be able to perform Security Force Assistance by advising, mentoring or training in order to improve the performance of designated actors.

TARGET AUDIENCE

1. Position:
 - NATO and Partner SFA Operators – Advisers, Mentors and Trainers
 - Military Officers (OF2 through OF5), experienced NCOs (OR6 to OR9) or civilian equivalents working as SFA operators in SFA operations.
 - NATO HQ IS/IMS, NATO Allied Command Operations (HQ SHAPE, Joint Force Commands, and Component Commands), NATO Allied Command Transformation (HQ SACT), COEs, NATO Force Structure and Potential Staff members.
 - NATO Partner countries and personnel in academia, IOs, GOs, NGOs, interagency, inter governmental and to personnel working in SSR projects and wider development context (incl. possible counterparts from priority regions/countries).
2. Educational background:
 - Participants shall be competent experts on their own field.

 - Specified pre-course homework before residential part of the course

a. Conference venue and time

The course will be held at the Italian Army Infantry School located in *Via della Stazione di Cesano, 423, 00123 – Cesano di Roma (Italy)*.

The training hours are Monday to Thursday, 08:30 to 17:00 and Friday, 08:30 to 13:30.

b. Registration

Applicants are kindly requested to register on NATO SFA COE website at <https://reserved.nsfacoe.org/site/view?id=81> no later than **17th March 2022**.

c. Language

The course will be held in English.

Level 3 in English proficiency is required according to NATO STANAG 6001: Listening (3); Speaking (2); Reading (3); and Writing (2) or according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Language level B2-C1/Upper Intermediate-Advanced level).

d. Classification

The overall classification of the course is UNCLASSIFIED.

e. Security measures

Participants are requested to bring their military/civilian passport or ID card to support their identification in order to receive the security badge that will be delivered on the first day, upon registration. This security badge must be carried throughout the event.

f. Visa Requirement

Attendees are responsible for arranging the required permits to enter the Italian territory (Request for Visit) by consulting their own HQ or embassy for procedures and timing.

Participants, or their national authorities, are responsible for visa arrangements (if needed). Participants are advised to contact, well in advance, proper diplomatic agencies for up-to-date information. It is the individual's responsibility to apply and obtain their visa and to have the proper travel documentation.

g. Medical service

First aid and emergency medical support is offered by the Italian Army Infantry School. Medical expenses must be paid by the individuals or their insurance agencies. All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance.

h. Course fee

The course fee is € 200.00 and will include the ice breaker, all lunches and coffee breaks.

NATO SFA COE strongly encourages early payment (by bank transfer) of the course fee. On site electronic payments (POS) will be accepted (as last resort) on the first day of the course (NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED).

Failure to pay course tuition fee by the first day of the course will result in the suspension of the course completion certificate for the student and the organization being put into collection status until the fee is paid.

i. Accommodation

Participants are responsible to arrange their own accommodation.

NATO SFA COE recommends staying at the Courtyard by Marriott Rome Central Park Hotel. The Hotel is very close to the 'Gemelli train station'.

The Centre has pre-booked single Rooms € 135/day and double rooms €155/day (breakfast included). Room reservations are available only by sending an email directly to the Hotel at groups@hotelcentralparkroma.com (specifying name, surname, check-in and check-out dates, credit card details) using "NATO SFA COE" as code.

Booking must be done no later than 25th March 2021. After this deadline room availability and preferential rates cannot be guaranteed.

j. Transportation

Course participants are expected to cover their own travel costs.

l. Dress code

The dress code is combat uniform for military personnel, smart casual for civilians.

m. Distance Learning option

Due to the ever-changing pandemic situation, the NATO SFA COE will adopt, as backup, a Distance Learning (DL) course in case of an escalation of restrictions or a new lockdown. Tailored instructions will be delivered in that event.

Course fee are requested even if the course is held in DL, but reduced to € 100,00.

Selected participants will be notified by 18th March 2022, in order to let them book their accommodation and arrange their own transportation.
