The NATO SFA COE is a multinational entity with Italy, Albania and Slovenia as the Sponsoring Nations. The project started in 2016 with the aim of promoting Stability and Reconstruction efforts for any crisis scenario and to become a SFA focal point for the Alliance. The Centre was formally created on the 13th of December 2017 with the-signature of the MOUs between the Sponsoring Nations and the Allied Command Transformation and officially obtained the NATO accreditation from the North Atlantic Council on the 3rd of December 2018.

On the 26th of March 2019, **Albania, Italy** and **Slovenia** celebrated the Opening Ceremony, that marked the introduction of the SFA COE to the community of NATO COEs.

The Centre's mission is to improve the effectiveness of the Alliance in promoting stability and reconstruction efforts for conflict and post-conflict scenarios through education, training and doctrine activities and also to provide a unique capability to the Alliance, NATO Nations, NATO Partners and International Organizations in the field of SFA.

The Conference has the aim of bringing together an international group of experts to talk about the challenges and the opportunities around SFA advising activities and goals as described in the book "Insights on Strategic Advising for Security Force Assistance". The authors will highlight the SFA related capacity building activities in fragile states, describing tools, behaviours, best practices and training methods for SFA advisors engaging in complex contexts while maintaining a comprehensive approach. The audience will have the opportunity to acquire lesson learned from multiple experiences and to engage in a productive discussion aimed at identifying important features through which the advisors can attain their objectives, ensuring sustainable and long-term stability.
